

Special meeting, March 15, 2016

A special building committee meeting was held Tuesday, March 15, 2016 with Francis Burch, Ryan Ide, Harlan Mathews, Gene Feltmann, Joann Feltmann and Rawelin Radtke of Ram Builders, Winsted in attendance.

Francis Burch called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

Francis read the Minn. Statute 365.10, subdivision 6. 'The electors may let the board buy or build a townhall or other building for use of town. Electors must decide the amount of money to be raised for that purpose. Once the town gets a sites for a townhall, the site must not be changed for another site, except by a vote choosing a new site. To get a new site, two thirds of those voting on the question must vote for it.'

Upon looking into the March 8, 2016 annual meeting minutes, there was a motion and second to proceed with an addition to the north of the existing townhall and the motion carried. No opposing votes were noted.

Francis Burch had talked to Mark Telecky at the zoning office and he stated that he did not see a problem in getting a variance.

The committee was meeting with Rawelin Radtke to discuss ideas for a townhall addition project. He will come back March 30, 2016 at 10:00 a.m. with building options and cost estimates.

The meeting was not recessed or adjourned.
